


The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is improving three bridges in the westbound lanes of Interstate 90 (I-90) west of Alberton in Mineral County. The bridges carry I-90 over:

- Old Highway 10 and Elizabeth Lane approximately 9 miles west of Alberton
- Clark Fork River near Alberton Gorge approximately 8 miles west of Alberton
- Clark Fork River near Cyr approximately 5 miles west of Alberton




The improved bridge structures will serve Montana and the traveling public well into the future, providing low-maintenance features and safety improvements to anticipated transportation needs. Improvements include:

- Replacing two bridge structures in the westbound I-90 lanes
- Improving and repairing the westbound bridge over Elizabeth Lane
- Upgrading guardrails and drainage.

ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE

The project design and right-of-way process is anticipated to be completed in 2025. The timeline for construction is contingent on the availability of funding and will be scheduled once the design plans are finalized.
