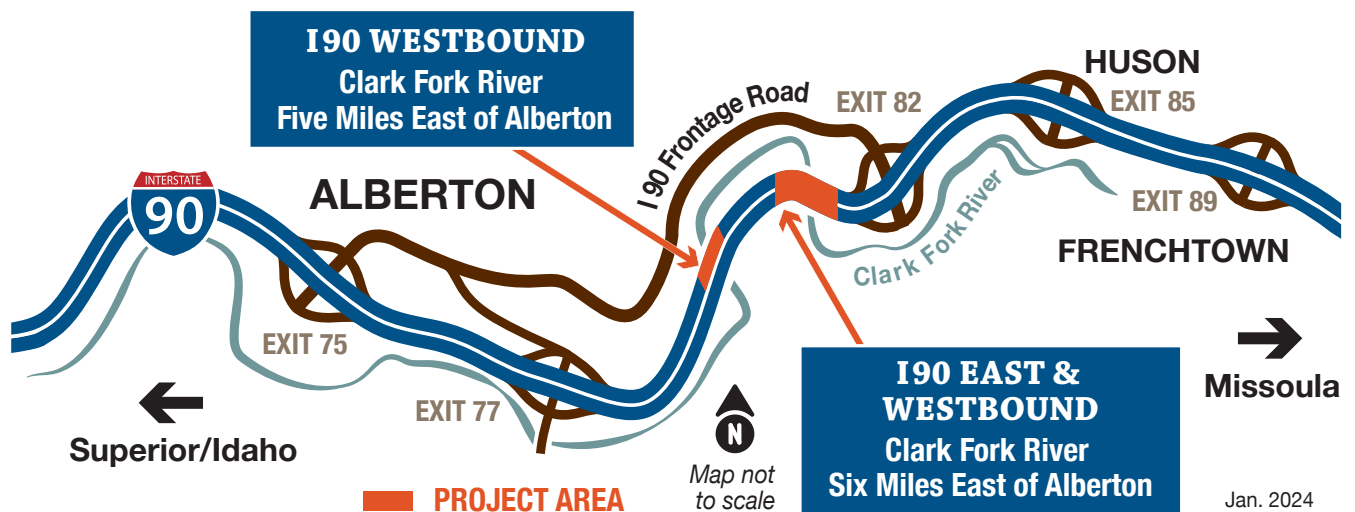


CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

I 90 Bridges East of Alberton

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is rehabilitating two bridges that carry Interstate 90 (I 90) over the Clark Fork River east of Alberton. The bridges include the westbound bridge located five miles east of Alberton and the bridge located six miles east of Alberton that carries both east and westbound traffic.



PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Replacing the concrete bridge deck on the eastbound portion of the six-mile bridge.
- Painting portions of the steel superstructures to slow corrosion.
- Replacing bridge joints and damaged bearings.
- Repairing bridge supports, called girders.
- Upgrading bridge drainage and guardrails.
- Resurfacing the pavement approaches on the bridges.
- Replacing the shoulder rumble strips and pavement striping.

WHY IS THE PROJECT NEEDED?

These bridges were originally built in the early 1960s and need repairs. This project will extend the service life of the bridges. This project will rehabilitate several bridge components and ensure that they are able to serve the traveling public for many years.

The eastbound portion of the six-mile bridge has deteriorated to the point where the deck needs to be fully removed and replaced.

ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE

Construction on the five-mile westbound bridge: Fall 2023 through late fall 2024.

Construction on the six-mile bridge: Early spring 2023 through late fall 2024.
