LETTING OF JUNE 6, 2024

Bids on the following projects will be received by the Montana Department of Transportation, Construction Contracting Bureau, until 9:00 a.m. on JUNE 6, 2024. All bids will then be reviewed for correctness and then publicly read in the Department's assigned room.

Bid proposals, plans, cross-sections, dirt runs & erosion control plans, if available, and full instructions to bidders may be obtained from the Construction Contracting Bureau's website: <http://www.mdt.mt.gov/business/contracting> under the "Bid Package" link. Additional bid letting information is also available on this website.

Persons or firms desiring to qualify or bid on highway construction on the basis of a joint venture must declare their intention by executing a "Declaration of Joint Venture and Power of Attorney." Joint Venture affidavits must be included with the Bid Proposal.

Any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement is subject to all appropriate state and federal civil rights laws. The prime and subcontractors are required to pay the wage rates set out in the bid proposal.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The following projects are funded in whole or in part by funds received from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and their construction is wholly contingent on the state's continued receipt of those federal funds. If the federal funds are reduced or not received, the Department may choose to terminate any or all of the contracts for convenience under the provisions of Subsection 108.10. Any bidder on these projects, by submitting its bid or bids, understands and accepts the possibility of the contracts being terminated in the event federal funds are reduced or not available and by submitting any bid, each bidder waives any claims for costs or damages other than as specifically allowed by Subsection 108.10.2. In particular, bidders understand and accept that no payment will be allowed for any claimed anticipated profit for work not performed.

MDT will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin or sex in the award, performance or administration of any MDT contract or in the administration of its DBE program (49 CFR Part 26). 102 SCHOOL SIDEWALKS - EAST HELENA TA 5899(71)

CONTRACT NO. 04624

Project School Sidewalks-East Helena will construct a new ADA/PROWAG-compliant concrete sidewalk along the north side of Lewis St. between Montana Ave./Valley Dr. and Kalispell Ave. The new sidewalk will provide connectivity between Prickly Pear Elementary School and East Valley Middle School with ADA-compliant walkways. The new sidewalk will include ADA-compliant curb ramps at Valley Dr. and Prickly Pear Ave. and will connect to the existing sidewalk on the south side of the Prickly Pear Elementary School approach (via a school crossing across Montana Ave./Valley Dr.) and existing sidewalk on the NE corner of Kalispell Ave. and Lewis St. Other work will include placement of new asphalt and/or gravel adjacent to the new sidewalk for transitions to existing ground, minor excavation, erosion control, striping, signing, delineation, and revegetation. Two new solar-powered rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFBs) will be included on the NE corner of Valley Dr. and Lewis St. and on the south side of the Prickly Pear Elementary School approach.
