

Dear Denton Highway neighbors,

Construction is now in progress for the MT-81 Bridges project. The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is replacing three aging bridges between Lewistown and Denton from April through October.

Crews are beginning work in April by replacing the bridge crossing over the irrigation canal near Meadow Creek Road with a box culvert. A box culvert is a tunnel-like structure that will allow water to flow underneath the roadway. In early summer, work will start on the Judith River Bridge and the Warm Spring Creek Bridge, east of Denton.



Drivers can expect to see travel limited to one-lane with minimal delays. Given the small work zones, vehicles hauling large loads are recommended to avoid the area whenever possible.

An open house was planned on March 24 but had to be canceled due to concerns about COVID-19. Please contact us via the information below if you have questions or concerns about construction. We are here to help!
