
The Fort Peck Tribes' Office of Environmental Protection has reviewed the February 21, 2012 Federal Register regarding the reissuance of all existing Nationwide Permits and the two new Nationwide Permits. Determinations for these NWP's are as follows:

Waive certification for Nationwide Permits 1, 2, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 21, 24, 28, 30, 31, 32, 34, 35, 41, 48, 50 and new Nationwide Permit 51.

Deny certification for Nationwide Permits 3, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 22, 23, 25, 27, 29, 33, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46 and new Nationwide Permit 52.
