Overview:

The Department has historically used two different cable guardrail systems: low-tension and high-tension. The Department is transitioning away from low-tension cable guardrail as currently depicted in the Detailed Drawings (NCHRP 350 devices) to using exclusively high-tension proprietary cable guardrail in response to the AASHTO/FHWA Joint Implementation Agreement for MASH. Not every system listed below meets the requirements of MASH and the Department will continue to install those systems until an acceptable MASH system is approved.
