

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Blackfoot Waterfowl Production Area was a cooperative project developed in 1988 with a consortium of partners including US Fish & Wildlife Service, Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks, Montana Department of Environmental Quality, US Environmental Protection, Federal Highway Administration, Ducks Unlimited and the Nature Conservancy. This group of state and federal agencies and non-profit conservation groups acquired and restored wetland habitat within a 1000-acre ranch in the Blackfoot River Valley. The wetland restoration is located on the south side of US Highway 200 and is located in Watershed # 2 – Upper Clark Fork River basin. For MDT's participation in the project, approximately 28 acres of wetland mitigation credits were assigned to be utilized to mitigate transportation projects within the watershed.
