Who's in charge here? ...

Recently we have been faced with questions pertaining to outside employment while owning/controlling a DBE firm. There are instances where this is allowed; however, according to the regulations (49 CFR §26.71(j)):

In order to be viewed as controlling a firm, a socially and economically disadvantaged owner cannot engage in outside employment or other business interests that conflict with the management of the firm or prevent the individual from devoting sufficient time and attention to the affairs of the firm to control its activities. For example, absentee ownership of a business and part-time work in a full-time firm are not viewed as constituting control. However, an individual could be viewed as controlling a part-time business that operates only on evenings and/or weekends, if the individual controls it all the time it is operating.

If you are considering outside employment call Rebecca Johnson to ensure your company will continue to meet the requirements of the DBE Program.

Maintenance Dept has taken over the contracted striping work in order to meet the traveling public's needs more effectively. They will have more just in time delivery of service. That means smaller contracts divided among areas. The department goal is 80% of all Montana highways will have acceptable reflective striping by July 1, 2002 and to have the road striped before it looks like it needs to be striped. Every fall, Maintenance Dept schedules meetings with contractors (paving, painting, and crack sealing) and vendors to meet and discuss issues and share information.
