About the MDT Library

Located in the Helena HQ building, the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) Library is an important part of the Department's Research Section. The library collects and preserves transportation-related information resources, making them available to both MDT employees and members of the public. If you're an MDT employee and you work outside of Helena, we can even ship material directly to your office.



Our collection contains nearly 30,000 titles in various formats, including all of MDT's final research reports, a comprehensive collection of publications from the Transportation Research Board (TRB), and other research reports from state, national, and international transportation organizations. We also offer professional development and FE/PE study material along with a range of engineering standards and specifications for employees. Last, our collection contains various works on the history of transportation.
