

Montana Motor Fuel Tax Refund Information for Estimate Allowed for Agricultural Use Claims

Use this table to determine what supporting documentation is needed to claim a refund of Montana's taxes paid on motor fuel. Please call 406 444-6030 for assistance.

Updated August 2021**

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- **Important!** Montana's motor fuel tax rates increased on July 1, 2021.
Gasoline tax is now \$.325 per gallon. Diesel tax is now \$.2955 per gallon.
Forms on MDT's website are now separated by year to match the tax rates.
Example: Choose the 2020 form to claim your fuel purchased in 2020.
- We encourage you to file your claim electronically! Call 406-444-6030 to learn how.
- Applications for a refund filed electronically do not require a signature or the original invoices. However, a claim filed electronically does not relieve the taxpayer of maintaining records on which the refund is based.
- Records supporting your claim for refund must be kept for a minimum of three years and be available for review by the department when requested.
- The name on the invoices must match the name on the application.
- A refund must be claimed within 36 months from the date of purchase.
- Income tax information is requested at least once every three years to determine qualification for the agricultural option. The highest percentage of agricultural income over a three-year period is used to determine qualification.
