Subject: eTRIPS Permitting System Launch

The Montana Department of Transportation, Motor Carrier Services Division will have a new *Electronic Transportation Routing and Intra/Interstate Permitting System* (eTRIPS) system, effective December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

# What you can expect:

- Overall enhancements and efficiency in the permitting process
- Continued automated routing that MT has used since February 8, 2021
- Restriction management for up-to-date construction and maintenance
- Increased self-issuing capabilities

### **Account Creation**

As part of the transition from the current ePART Montana permitting system new accounts will need to be created. Your previous information will not automatically migrate to the eTRIPS system. All carriers will be required to create an account before ordering a permit. Company accounts cannot be created until <u>December 8</u>, <u>2025</u>. See the FAQ document for this information.

# Permit History

Once the eTRIPS system launches on December 8<sup>th</sup>, permits previously issued by ePART will not be carried over to eTRIPS. It is recommended that you save any needed permits previously issued for future reference.
