 - i. MDT LOI with MOLF project-specific: needed after feasibility study is complete
 - ii. MDT 3rd party agreement, const of project Project specific MOU with MOLF and applicant
 - iii. MSWP MOLF and donors Project specific or Statewide pooling, but latter likely not big deal
 - (1) MSWP met with MOLF re: process between MSWP and MOLF, project vs. statewide pools of money update (KP)
 - (2) How does this work in other states? Or at MOLF for other purposes? (MSWP)
 - DW: Ideal to have this defined as soon as possible, KP: sometime mid-June.

This money could support upcoming projects that are MWTP-led or other MDT-led WAP crossings projects (i.e. could go to any wildlife accommodation project occurring in MT, non-necessarily via MWTP).

KM/DW: Objectives need to be clear. Could we set up a subgroup to help conceptualize what would need to come together (e.g., Planning, funding, messages, goals and objectives). What other steps, timing, legislature?

KP: Could there be a mini-summit that doesn't take too much lift because there's a lot of interest in the state re: wildlife crossings?

Exploratory committee – Create a straw dog of objectives, etc. – ST recommend talking to CO folks, review MT summit docs, can dig through MDT files related to the summit.
