



7TH AVENUE NORTH INTERSECTIONS

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and Knife River are upgrading five intersections on 7th Avenue North in Bozeman. The project begins at the West Main Street intersection and continues north, ending near the Nikles Drive/Wheat Drive intersection. This project will also widen Peach Street and Oak Street near 7th Avenue North, to better facilitate the flow of traffic.

CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

This project is anticipated to begin in July, and most work will be completed in a single season. Chip seal and final pavement markings will likely be completed in 2026.



IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE

- Upgrading signals and sidewalks to be Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant
- Widening Peach Street to provide a dedicated westbound left turn lane
- Widening Oak Street to restore the shoulder
- Crack sealing and adding a seal and cover (chip seal) on 7th Avenue North between West Main Street and the Nikles Drive/Wheat Drive intersection
- Milling and paving sections of the road with deep ruts
- Applying final pavement markings
