



PROJECT DETAILS


Flathead County and the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) will replace the existing Bridge Street Bridge with a new, structurally similar bridge.





TENTATIVE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT TIMELINE











ANTICIPATED WORK SCHEDULE

Project Area Impacts




Pedestrians

The bridge will be closed during construction, and there are no plans to build a temporary walkway. Project site constraints and construction activity will make a temporary walkway infeasible.



Bridge Street Access

The closure will only affect the areas immediately adjacent to the bridge and the bridge itself. The entrances of area residences and businesses will not be affected.



Sliter's Park

The park will be used as a staging area for construction. It will be closed to the public until the project is complete.



Downtown Access

Pedestrians and vehicles will continue to use Grand Drive to access downtown Bigfork. Destinations southwest of the bridge can be accessed using Bridge Street from the Montana Highway 209 (MT 209) or Montana Highway 35 (MT 35) turn-offs.
