BIG MOUNTAIN ROAD

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT), in partnership with Knife River, is resuming construction on the Big Mountain Road project north of Whitefish.

Construction is expected to begin in early June and continue through the fall, weather and other factors permitting. Planned work includes pavement overlays as well as areas of road repair. Work will occur between Smith Road and Glades Drive, beginning at the project's south end and working north.

Travelers will be directed to one-lane traffic via flaggers and pilot cars. Expect reduced speeds and delays. Cyclists and motorcyclists are encouraged to use extreme caution.
