## Billings Bypass Construction Update: Yellowstone River Bridge Work Resumes

The Montana Department of Transportation has re-started construction on the Billings Bypass Yellowstone River Bridge, anticipating completion by the end of the summer. The area is an active construction site and remains closed to the public.

The bridge is the second of six total project segments that comprise the entire Billings Bypass project. Once the third project segment, the Railroad Overpass to the south of the new bridge, is complete the public will be able to drive the new connection between Lockwood and the Billings Heights using a temporary connection to Coulson Road. The Railroad Overpass project segment is anticipated to begin construction in late 2022 and take two years to complete.

This project is led by the Montana Department of Transportation in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Yellowstone County, and City of Billings. DOWL is the lead project engineer and public information coordinator and Morrison-Maierle is the lead bridge engineer. Wadsworth Brothers Construction is building the bridge.

**Work zone safety reminder:** The Yellowstone River Bridge construction zone is closed to the public for public safety. Members of the public interested in viewing progress may watch the construction webcam available on the project website


