Open House Planned for Billings Bypass

BILLINGS, Mont. - The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is hosting an open house to update the public on the status of the design and construction phases of the Billings Bypass arterial roadway that will connect Lockwood and Billings Heights.

The open house will be held Tuesday, May 14, from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Eileen Johnson Middle School - Commons, 1932 US 87 E, Billings, MT 59101.

The meeting will provide the following updates for the project:

- **Construction Update:** *Railroad Overpass and upcoming Johnson Lane Interchange.*
- **Design Update:** *Johnson Lane Interchange – Railroad Overpass and Five Mile Road to US 87.*
