# JORDAN TO BROCKWAY

LITTLE DRY CREEK - EAST

## Section 2: Junction 462 East & West

**About 9.5 miles**  
Junction 462 East/West will include reconstruction of just less than 9.5 miles of Highway 200, from 17 miles east of Jordan, MT to just east of the Little Dry Creek Bridge. The roadway will be reconstructed to include a six-foot wide road shoulder, rumble strips on the centerline and shoulder, new drainage structures, and additional signage and striping. A new bridge will be constructed over Little Dry Creek.

## Section 3: Flowing Wells East & West

**About 7 miles**  
Flowing Wells East/West will include the reconstruction of just less than 7 miles of Highway 200 with a six-foot wide road shoulder, rumble strips on the centerline and shoulder, new drainage structures, and additional signage and striping.

## Section 1: Little Dry Creek - East

**About 7 miles**  
Reconstruction of just more than 7 miles of Highway 200 between Little Dry Creek Bridge and the Flowing Wells Rest Area. Updates include a six-foot road shoulder, rumble strips on the centerline and road shoulder, new drainage structures, and additional signage and striping. The construction contract has been awarded to Wickens Construction and will begin in 2021.

*Due to a crash cluster in this area, construction will start here to create the safest conditions throughout the Highway 200 reconstruction project.*

## Section 4: West of Brockway - West

**About 7 miles**  
West of Brockway will include reconstruction of just less than 7 miles of Highway 200. Look for a six-foot wide road shoulder, rumble strips on the centerline and shoulder, new drainage structures, and additional signage and striping.

## Section 5: Brockway - West

**About 7 miles**  
Brockway to Secondary 253 will include the reconstruction of just less than 7 miles of Highway 200 to the intersection with Secondary 253 (north of Brockway, MT). The roadway will be reconstructed to meet current design standards. Additions will include a six-foot wide road shoulder, rumble strips on the centerline and shoulder, new drainage structures, and additional signage and striping.
