

# Sieben North



Pavement Preservation



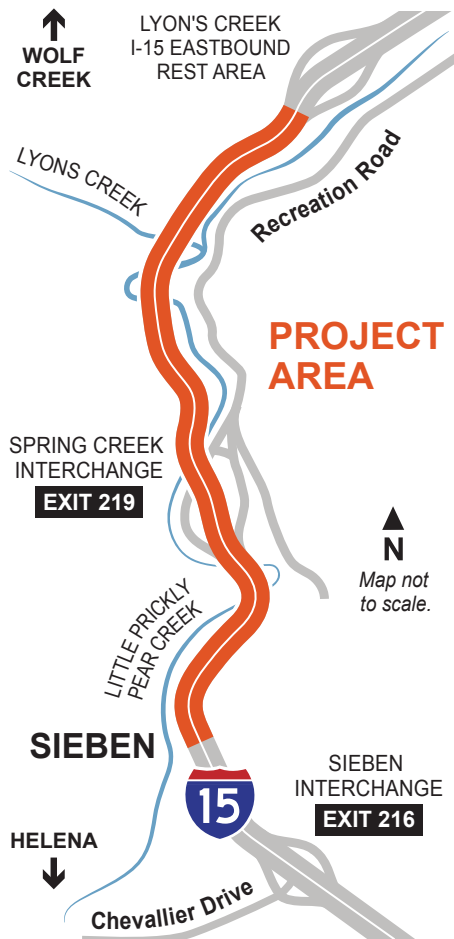
The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and Jeffery Contracting Inc. will rehabilitate approximately 4 miles of Interstate 15 (I-15) north of the Sieben Interchange (Exit 216). The project area begins just north of the Sieben Interchange and extends north approximately 4 miles, ending about 5 miles south of Wolf Creek.

## Improvements include:

- Removing and replacing more than a foot of degraded roadway material on I-15
- Upgrading concrete barrier rails, metal guardrail, and signage
- Adding concrete barrier delineation (high-visibility reflective strips) on inside curves
- Replacing right-of-way fencing and cattle guards as needed
- Resurfacing the Spring Creek Interchange (Exit 219) ramps
- Removing a culvert and rerouting drainage through a new storm drainpipe on the east side of the Spring Creek Interchange
- Adding new pavement markings
- Applying a seal and cover (chip seal)

## Why is the project needed?

This project will address the deteriorated roadway in a manner that will decrease long-term maintenance costs and extend its service life. The upgraded signage and roadway markers were included as part of this project to enhance safety along this corridor.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2026 and take 2 years to complete.

### When construction begins, motorists can anticipate:

- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Both north and southbound traffic will travel on the same side of I-15.
- Crossover traffic patterns will be in place throughout construction.
- Speed limits will be reduced.
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place (visit [511mt.net](http://511mt.net) for the most up-to-date information).
