

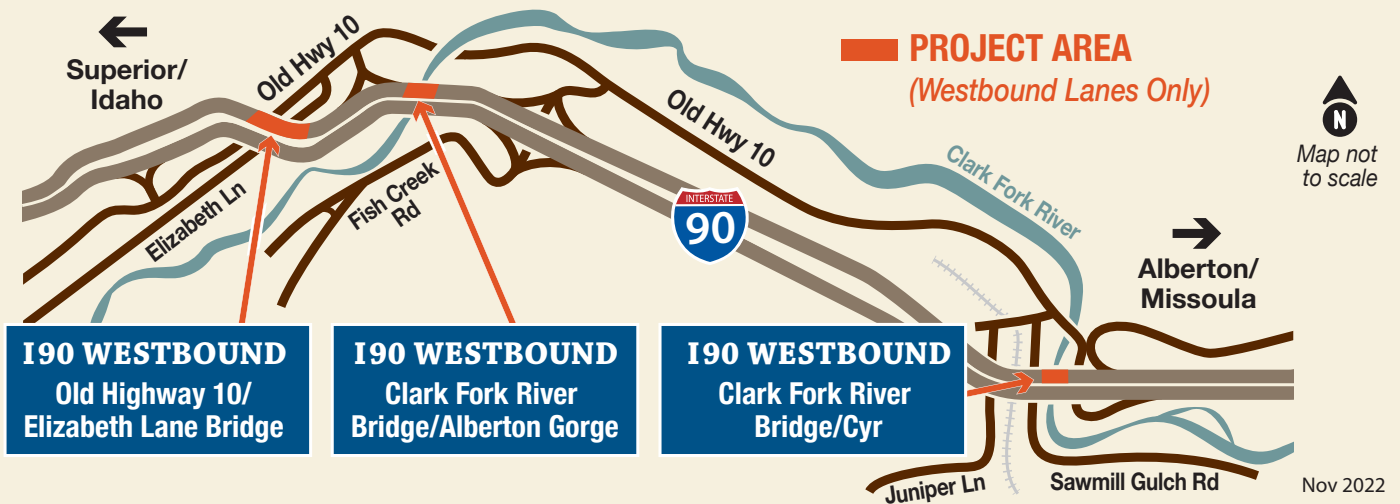
190 Bridges



WEST OF ALBERTON

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is improving three bridges in the westbound lanes of Interstate 90 (I 90) west of Alberton in Mineral County. The bridges carry I 90 over:

- Old Highway 10 and Elizabeth Lane 9 ½ miles west of Alberton
- Clark Fork River near Alberton Gorge approximately 8 ½ miles west of Alberton
- Clark Fork River near Cyr approximately 5 miles west of Alberton

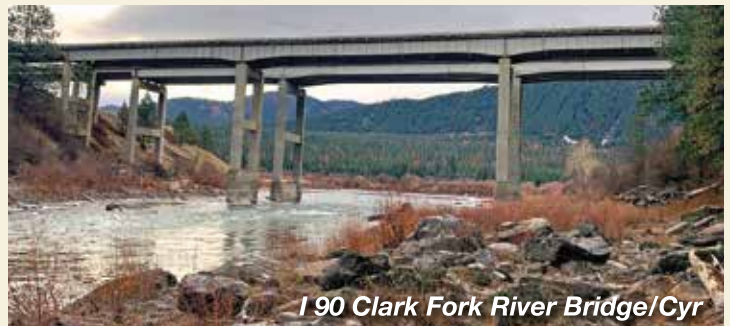


The improved bridge structures will serve Montana and the traveling public well into the future, providing low-maintenance features and safety improvements to anticipated transportation needs. Improvements include:

- Replacing two bridge structures in the westbound I 90 lanes
- Improving and repairing the westbound bridge over Elizabeth Lane
- Upgrading guardrails and drainage.

ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE

The project design and right-of-way process is anticipated to be completed in 2025. The timeline for construction is contingent on the availability of funding and will be scheduled once the design plans are finalized.
