Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the purpose of the project?

The project will reduce delays, improve traffic flow, and enhance traveler safety at a busy intersection located on North 7th Avenue, north of Interstate 90.

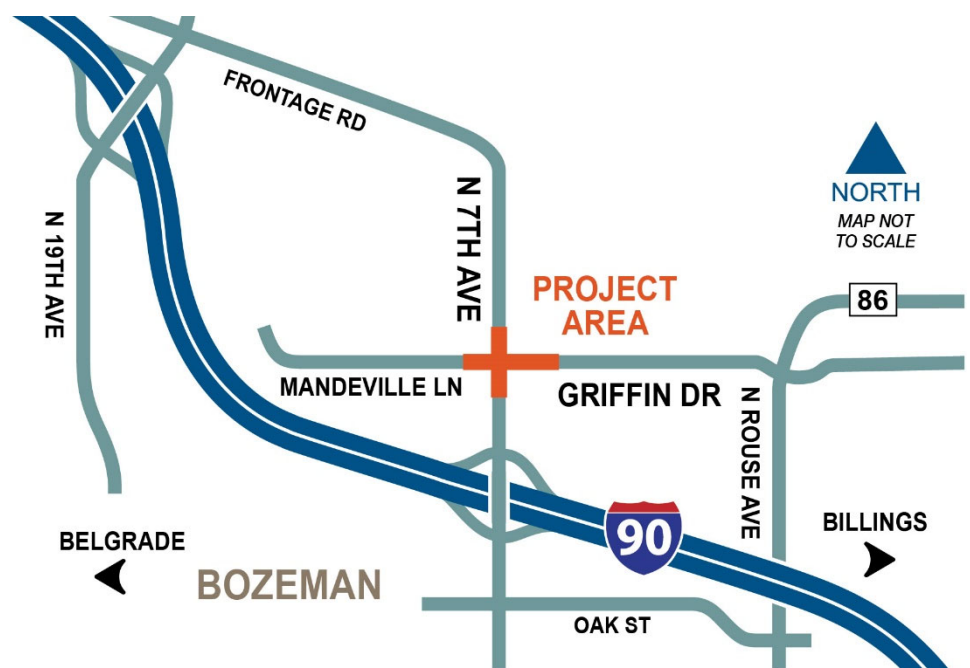
2. Where is the project?

The project takes place at the intersection of North 7th Avenue, Griffin Drive, and Mandeville Lane just north of Interstate 90 in Bozeman.

3. What improvements are being made?

Improvements include:

- New turn lanes.
- Durable concrete pavement.
- ADA-compliant Sidewalk.
- Bicycle accommodations.
- Curb, gutter, and storm drainage.
- Traffic signals and lighting.



4. How will these improvements benefit the area?

New turn lanes will help traffic move efficiently and safely through the intersection. Pedestrian and bicycle mobility will be improved by adding new sidewalks, shared-use paths, and lighting. Additional curbs, gutters, and storm drainage will help prevent flooding and reduce long-term maintenance costs.

5. What is the project schedule?

Construction is anticipated to begin in June 2023 and be completed in late fall.
