



The scope of work on the
RONAN-NORTH PROJECT INCLUDES:



Widening the highway to four lanes - two lanes in each direction.



Installation of a new traffic signal at the Old US 93 and 3rd Avenue intersection.



Permanent closure of Spring Creek Road at US 93.



Construction of a new shared-use path connecting Round Butte Road with the existing path along US 93.



Construction of a short, 600-foot, two-lane segment on 1st Avenue, starting at Round Butte Road in preparation for the construction of the Ronan-Urban project.

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and Riverside Contracting, Inc.

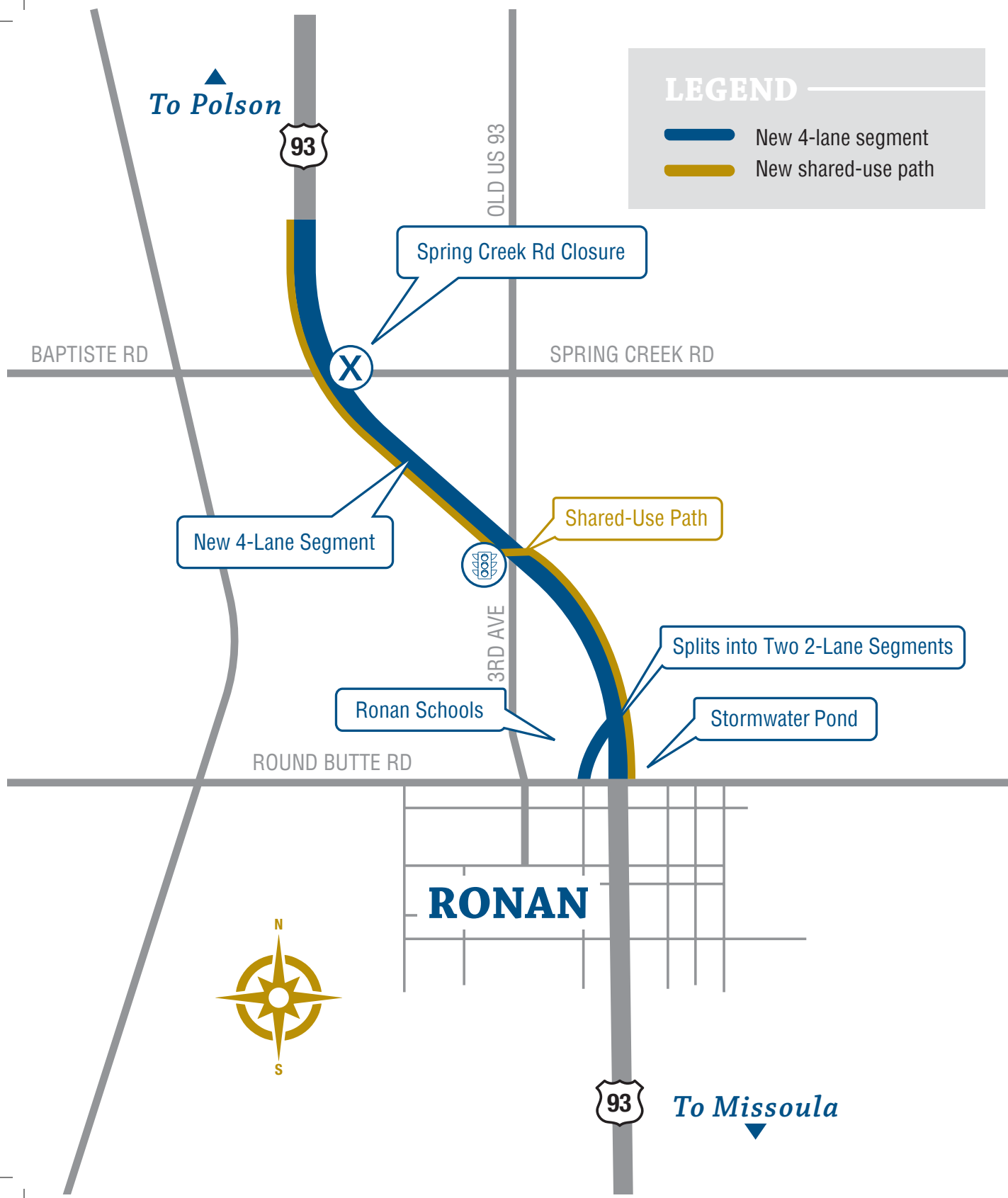
are excited to announce that work on the Ronan-North reconstruction project will begin on Monday, October 31.

The project starts at the Round Butte Road intersection in Ronan and extends north for approximately 2 miles on US Highway 93 (US 93).

WORK SCHEDULE

Work will occur on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. This schedule is subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

WORK TO BE COMPLETED FALL 2022

- Clearing of all unwanted surface and underground vegetative materials along the roadsides.
- Installation of a 54-inch irrigation pipe.
- If weather permits, earthmoving operations will begin on the project's north end.

2023 CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE

The project will be completed in three phases:

- Phase 1:** West half of the road (southbound) is to be widened, a drainage pipe and storm drain installed, and gravel placed.
- Phase 2:** East half of the road (northbound) is to be widened, a drainage pipe and storm drain installed, and gravel placed.
- Phase 3:** Paving, striping, and other finishing work.

TENTATIVE CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE

The project's timeline is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen factors.
