RED LODGE TO ROBERTS

Dear Carbon County Neighbors,

The US 212 corridor is a major thoroughfare, both for locals and for tourists traveling in and out of state. Originally paved in 1983, US 212 has not received improvements since being repaved in 2002. Meanwhile, the Treasure State's beauty has drawn many to the area, steadily adding to the population and increasing tourism.

To address safety, growth and reconstruction needs for the corridor, the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is launching the **US 212 – Red Lodge to Roberts** project. Nearly 10 miles of roadway between Red Lodge and Roberts will be widened and fully reconstructed. **Attend our virtual open house to learn more about the project, provide your thoughts and ask questions.**
