



# Wolf Creek Bridges

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is improving the Interstate 15 (I 15) bridges and the Little Prickly Pear Creek Bridge in Wolf Creek. Construction will address the worn-down surfaces of these three bridges, providing a smoother driving surface and keeping the bridges safe and operational well into the future.

## IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Resurfacing the northbound and southbound I 15 bridges
- Replacement of the Little Prickly Pear Creek Bridge deck (driving surface)

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

### I 15 Bridges

- Access to Wolf Creek on- and off-ramps will be maintained.
- Pedestrian traffic under the bridges will be maintained.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Both north and southbound traffic will travel on the same side of I 15.
- Speed limit will be reduced.
- Width restrictions will be in place (visit [www.511mt.net](http://www.511mt.net) for the most up-to-date information).

### Little Prickly Pear Creek Bridge

- Access over the bridge will be maintained.
- Traffic will be reduced to alternating one-way traffic.
- Lane widths and turning movements will be reduced for large vehicles.
- The northbound I 15 on-ramp will be widened temporarily to help truck turning movements.

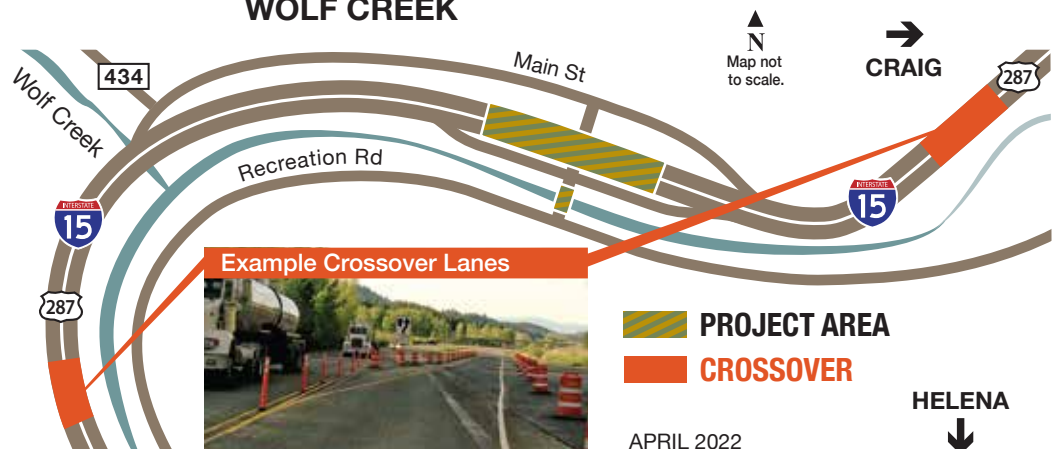
