Wolf Creek Bridges

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is improving the Interstate 15 Bridges and Little Prickly Pear Creek Bridge in Wolf Creek.

Planned improvements include resurfacing the Interstate 15 bridges and replacing the deck of the Little Prickly Pear Creek Bridge. This work will extend the service life of the bridges, reduce maintenance costs, and provide a smooth driving surface. Construction is expected to take 3-4 months to complete.

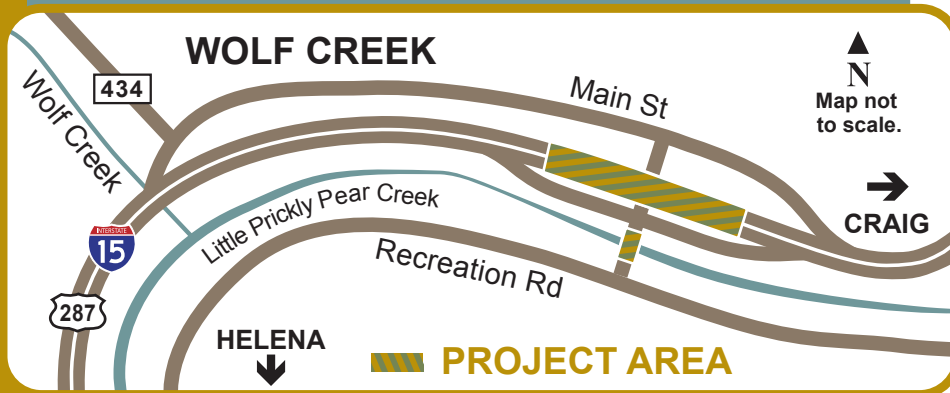
