Trauma System Development

- Central Trauma Registry
 - More severely injury patients requiring
 - Higher levels of resources
 - Team approach to optimal trauma care
 - Provides trauma data for:
 - Demographics of severe injury in Montana
 - Identification of patient care issues for all phases of care
 - Development of trauma system performance improvement indicators
 - Injury prevention



Trauma System Development

- Preventable Death Study
 - Conducted around the country as an evaluation tool
 - Montana's 1rst study conducted in 1992 first rural study in the country
 - Overall preventable death rate = 13%
 - Follow-up study conducted in 1998
 - Overall preventable death rate = 8%
 - Now conducting a 3rd study of 2008 deaths
