
2010 OLDER DRIVER CRASH HIGHLIGHTS

Age 65+

Fatalities	36	39	+8.3%
Injuries	992	1,078	+8.7%
Severe Injuries	164	206	+25.6%
Fatal Crashes	35	29	-17.1%
Injury Crashes	700	734	+4.9%
Property Damage Only Crashes	2,090	2,094	+0.2%
Alcohol-Related Fatalities	3	6	+100.0%
Unbelted Fatalities	16	8	-50.0%

Older driver may not have been at fault & older driver may not have suffered injury.

STRATEGY 2 FOR OLDER DRIVERS COMMITTEE

- Promote Safe Driving Practices for Older Drivers.
 - Committee is currently recruiting new partners to attend meetings
 - 2010 Trainings
 - 2011 Trainings, Conferences
 - PSA, and TV (Aging Horizons)

STRATEGY 3 FOR OLDER DRIVERS COMMITTEE

 - Transportation Summit is working to get the Public Transportation link on all state websites for easy access.
