

Montana's Highway Safety Plan

- Each year the State Highway Traffic Safety Section submits a HSP (Section 402) to NHTSA – due July 1
- Section 405 applications are also due July 1

 The HSP is posted on the MDT website as soon as NHTSA approves the plan

NHTSA Safety Programs FAST Act

- Section 402 Highway Safety Plan funding, Teen
- Section 405(B) Occupant Protection
- Section 405 (C) Traffic Records, Data and IT Projects
- Section 405 (D) Impaired Driving, High Visibility Enforcement, 24/7 Sobriety Program
- Section 405 (F) Motorcycles
- Section 164 Alcohol



Grant Application Process

- Annual Process Applications to MDT due March 1st
 Web grants system
- Tie to CHSP Proposal for funding need to be a strategy in the Comprehensive Highway Safety Plan
- Applications ranked grant decisions will be based on a ranking criteria – data analysis, goals & objectives, past performance, and other considerations, including available funding



FFY 2019 Annual Grant Cycle

- March 1, 2018 Applications due to SHTSS through Web grants
- March April, 2018 SHTSS review and make funding recommendations to GR
- May June 30, 2018 Highway Safety Plan prepared & approved by GR
- July 1, 2018 Highway Safety Plan and 405 Applications due to NHTSA
- September 2018 Award letters sent to sub grantees
- October 1, 2018 Contracts executed with sub grantees
