






#### The Plan

  - Unbelted Occupants
    - Driver & Passenger Behavior
    - Other contributing factors
      - Speeding
      - Distractions/ Inattentiveness

- Roadway Departure Crashes
  - Road Safety Audit, Safety Edge, Chevron Delineation & Friction Control, Median Barriers



 Roundabouts, Retroreflective Backplates, Pedestrian Median & Island Crossings, Dedicated Turn Lanes at Two-Way Stop Controlled Intersections

  - Strong DUI Laws
  - High Visibility Enforcement
  - Effective Prosecution & Adjudication
  - Alcohol Problem Assessment & Treatment
  - Alcohol Screening & Brief Intervention
  - Enforcement of Drug-Impaired Driving



- State Primary Seat Belt Use Law
- Short-term, High Visibility Seat Belt Law Enforcement
- Communication and awareness in supporting enforcement

# The Barrier -Inadequate Laws-

Attempt to Improve Alcohol-Impaired Driving Law (Proven safety countermeasure)

> SB 65- Generally revise drug and alcohol laws

-Did Not Pass-66<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session



The Barriers
-Inadequate Law-

Primary Seat Belt Law (proven safety countermeasure)

 HB 49- Create the Vehicle Occupant Protection Safety Pilot Program

 Public surveys have shown that Montana residents support a primary seat belt law.

Did Not Pass - 66<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session

Numerous efforts at Primary Seat
 Belt Legislation since 2001 by 4
 different Republican Legislators & by
 3 different Democrat Legislators



#### The Solutions

Needs a primary seat belt bill with strong sponsors – one from each party.

Need to revisit Reviewing the Drug and Alcohol Impaired Driving laws for the next Legislative Session.



#### The Solutions

Promote Safety Driver Behaviors

Remove "accidents" when speaking about transportation or traffic data.

Improve Montana's driving standards and laws
